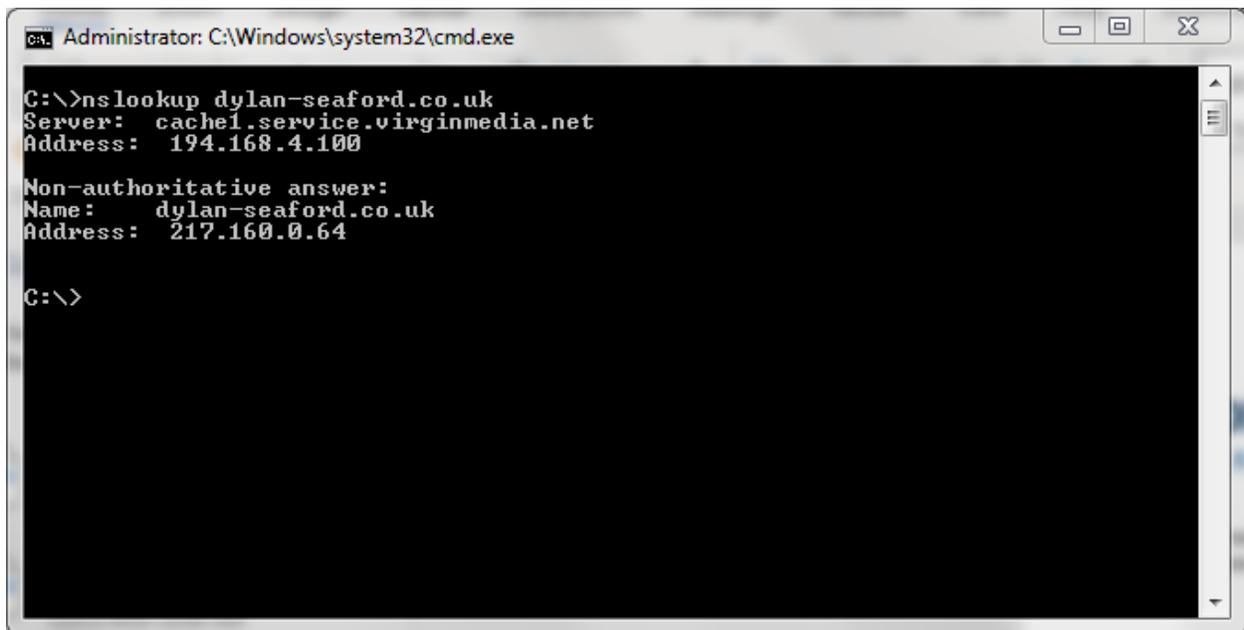


DOMAIN NAME SYSTEM (DNS)

A Domain Name System (DNS) translates uniform resource locator (URL) and domain names to the numerical IP addresses needed for locating and identifying computer on the internet.

nslookup (name server lookup) is a network administration command-line tool for querying the Domain Name System (DNS) to obtain domain name or IP address mapping.
