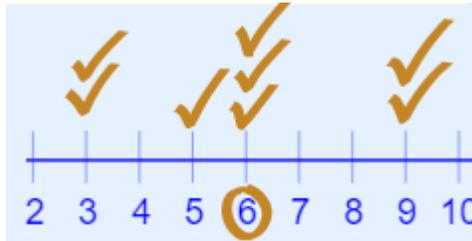


MODE OR MODAL VALUE

Key Revision Facts: GCSE Maths

The mode or modal value is simply the number which appears most often. In {6, 3, 9, 6, 6, 5, 9, 3} the Mode is 6, as it occurs most often.



Having two modes in a list called "bimodal". Having more than two modes is called "multimodal".

Example: {1, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 9}

3 appears three times, as does 6.

So there are two modes: at 3 and 6
